Winnie Campbell	<p><u>Ayr Road/Capington Road Junction, Kilmarnock</u></p> <p>Winnie raised concerns regarding difficulties for pedestrians crossing Ayr Road in the vicinity of the above junction and asked for this to be investigated as it was dangerous.</p>	<p>It was agreed that Sharon McHarg would arrange for the matter to be investigated by the Executive Director of Development and Property Services and that he would report back directly to Winnie Campbell.</p> <p>The Acting Head of Roads and Transportation has advised that the concerns will be investigated.</p>
Joan Wark	<p><u>Marchdyke Crescent – Grass Area/Car Parking</u></p> <p>Joan referred to her enquiry at Committee on 21 March 2002 and 7 September 2005 regarding Marchdyke Crescent and the possibility of the grass area being partially removed or possibly replaced by car parking and asked for an update on the position.</p>	<p>It was agreed Sharon McHarg would contact John Pickering, Area Manager and request an update on the position and that he would report back directly to Joan Wark.</p> <p>A letter has now been issued to Joan Wark advising that there is no change to the previously stated position and it remains that there is no funding available to convert the grassed area and it is unlikely that this position will change in the foreseeable future.</p>
