1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

- 1.1 To request that the Sub-Committee consider attendance at the Annual Conference of the Chartered Institute of Housing in Scotland.

2. BACKGROUND

- 2.1 The Chartered Institute of Housing in Scotland has advised authorities that the annual conference of the Institute will take place in Aberdeen at the Aberdeen Exhibition and Conference Centre from 6 – 9 March 2006. The programme has been structured to include specialist sessions on a range of housing issues in addition to keynote speakers.

The conference is considered to be relevant to Officers and Elected Members who are involved in housing and will afford delegates the opportunity to discuss and debate what is happening in Scotland.

- 2.2 There are a range of housing conferences held throughout the year but it has been the practice to restrict attendance to those conferences which offer the maximum advantage to the Council. The Chartered Institute of Housing in Scotland Conference is one of these where representation is recommended.

3. FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

- 3.1 The delegates fee for this three day conference is £503 plus vat.

4. RECOMMENDATIONS
