GLENAFTON ATHLETIC JUNIOR FOOTBALL CLUB

Report by Depute Chief Executive/Executive Director of Corporate Support

1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

- 1.1 The purpose of the report is to request that the Sub-Committee consider an application from Glenafton Athletic Junior Football Club for a contribution towards their 75th Anniversary Celebrations to take place between May and August this year.

2. BACKGROUND

- 2.1 Glenafton Athletic and Sporting Club are a Junior Football Club located in New Cumnock. They promote and encourage six children's football clubs based at Loch Park, New Cumnock.
- 2.2 The group was formed in 1930 and will hold a series of events to commemorate their 75th anniversary to take place from May to August 2005.

3. FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

- 3.1 The group has estimated the total cost of the event being £8,000.
- 3.2 The group has requested a contribution of £275 for their event to be held in May which will be held in a marquee at Loch Park, New Cumnock and will be attended by between 300 and 400 people consisting of ex-Glenafton players, officials, members of the community and elected member representation.

4. POLICY IMPLICATIONS

- 4.1 The Council policy for dealing with applications for recognition of anniversary celebrations from local groups, establishments etc was approved by this Sub Committee on 31 January 2001 and recommended 25th to 100th anniversary celebrations equals £3 per year, so therefore, for a 75th anniversary celebration the recommended amount would be £3 x 75 = £225.

6. RECOMMENDATIONS

- 6.1 The Sub-Committee is asked to:-

- (i) consider the request from Glenafton Athletic Junior Football Club for a contribution towards their 75th anniversary celebrations; and
- (ii) remit the necessary arrangements to the Depute Chief Executive/Executive Director of Corporate Support in consultation with the Chair.
