CROSSHOUSE BOYS CLUB

Report by the Depute Chief Executive/Executive Director of Corporate Support

1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

- 1.1 The purpose of the report is to advise the Sub-Committee of an application received from Crosshouse Boys Club seeking a contribution of £50.00 towards an event to celebrate their 25th Anniversary and also the Under 16's winning the Scottish Cup this year.

2. BACKGROUND

- 2.1 The Club has over 130 boys and girls aged from 6 to 18.
- 2.2 The players and coaches are all registered and certified with the Scottish Youth Football Association.
- 2.3 The Group are planning to have the event in February 2006, possibly in Crosshouse Bowling Club. The event will be attended by approximately 70 guests.

3. FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

- 3.1 The Group has estimated a total cost of the event as being £100.00 and has requested a contribution of £50.00.

4. POLICY IMPLICATIONS

- 4.1 Council policy for dealing with applications for recognition of anniversary celebrations from local groups, establishments etc approved by this Sub-Committee on 31 January 2001, recommends that 25th to 50th Anniversary celebrations equals £3.00 per year so, therefore, for a 25th Anniversary, the recommended amount would be £3.00 x £25.00 equals £75.00.

6. RECOMMENDATIONS

- 6.1 The Sub-Committee is asked to:-

- (i) consider the request from Crosshouse Boys Club for a contribution of £50.00 to mark their 25th Anniversary and the Under 16's winning the Scottish Cup; and

- (ii) remit the necessary arrangements, including Council representation, to the Depute Chief Executive/Executive Director of Corporate Support, in consultation with the Chair.
