AUCHINLECK INDOOR BOWLING CLUB - BRITISH ISLES JUNIOR INTERNATIONAL SERIES

Report by the Acting Executive Director of Corporate Support

1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

- 1.1** The purpose of the report is to request that the Sub-Committee consider an application from Auchinleck Indoor Bowling Club to provide a civic dinner to be held on 16 January 2005.

2. BACKGROUND

- 2.1** Auchinleck Indoor Bowling Club will be hosting the British Isles Junior International Series on 15 and 16 January 2005.
- 2.2** The tournament will consist of four teams and officials from each of the home Countries, Scotland, England, Ireland and Wales, competing in a round robin tournament over the two days.
- 2.3** There will be 16 players per team and the best team over three games will take the international title.
- 2.4** The Club are applying for civic hospitality in the form of a civic dinner to be held in the Stadium on Sunday 16 January 2005 and will be attended by approximately 130-140 people consisting of Officials and players from all four teams, Committee Members, the Provost and up to three other Elected Members.

3. PREVIOUS ASSISTANCE

- 3.1** Auchinleck Indoor Bowling Club received £200.00 from this Sub-Committee in November 2000 to assist with the cost of a civic lunch in connection with the British Isles Ladies Bowling Championship and the Home International Series.

4. FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

- 4.1** The Club has advised that they will have added expenses for tickets, programmes, seating and additional staffing costs and therefore requesting a contribution of £400.00 for a civic dinner.

5. POLICY IMPLICATIONS

- 5.1** Council protocol for determining Council representation at such civic events was approved by Council on 27 June 2002 and recommends that, where this Sub-Committee does not determine Council representation then the Chief Executive, in consultation with the Chair of the Members' Services and Civic Ceremonial Sub-Committee and the Provost will determine Council representation.

6. LEGAL IMPLICATIONS - NIL.

7. RECOMMENDATIONS

- 7.1** The Sub-Committee is asked to:-

- (i) consider the request from Auchinleck Indoor Bowling Club for a civic dinner at a cost of no more than £400.00; and
- (ii) remit the necessary arrangements to the Chief Executive in consultation with the Chair.
