1. Community Representative Jean Brown again raised the issue of the road layout at the A77 – A719.	It was agreed that the Administrative Officer invite an officer from the Department of Roads and Transportation to the next meeting of the Local Committee to discuss the layout and answer any questions the Committee may have.	Adam Beatie, Technical Officer will be in attendance at the meeting.
2. Community Representative Charles Lindsay again raised the issue of water lying on the steps of the School at David Dale Avenue, Stewarton and also advised that there was a shrub at the steps that required cutting back.	It was agreed that the Administrative Officer write to the Executive Director of Educational and Social Services to ask him to investigate if there was a problem with flooding as there always seems to be water lying there, especially after a heavy rainfall, and also to look at cutting back the shrub at the step.	The Head of Resource Support has advised that he has contacted the Council's Property Section and asked them to arrange a visit to the School as soon as possible to examine whether there is a flooding issue. He has also asked his own Property staff to contact Grounds Maintenance and ensure that the shrubs are pruned where necessary.
3. Community Representative Charles Lindsay advised that lighting contractors working in David Dale Avenue, Stewarton had been leaving pieces of plastic piping behind the wall along David Dale Avenue.	It was agreed that the Administrative Officer write to the Principle Engineer, Lighting to ask him to investigate.	Len Paget, Principal Engineer advised that the piping had been removed.
