NAMING OF STREETS BY LOCAL COMMITTEES – DEVELOPMENT OFF OLD GLASGOW ROAD, STEWARTON

1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

- 1.1 To request the Committee to consider names for three streets at a new development off Old Glasgow Road, Stewarton.

2. BACKGROUND

- 2.1 The Decentralisation Sub-Committee of the Policy and Resources Committee, at its meeting on 4 June 1996, agreed that the naming of streets be included within the remit of Local Committees.
- 2.2 Section 97 of the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982 gives authority to East Ayrshire Council in relation to naming of streets and the preparation of house numbers etc.
- 2.3 The Local Member, Councillor Maureen McKay, and Stewarton and District Community Council, have been informed of the development and requested to put forward suggestions on the names for the streets to this Committee.

3. CURRENT POSITION

- 3.1 Stewarton and District Community Council, in consultation with Councillor McKay, have suggested the names Holmhead Drive, Annickbank and Ostler Place.

5. RECOMMENDATIONS

- 5.1 It is recommended:-
- (i) that the Committee name the streets at the new development off Old Glasgow Road, Stewarton;
