However, last years grant had a restriction placed on it as the club were looking for running costs for the club. This is the third year the club have applied and are still looking for money towards running costs.

The club is also sometimes hired out for birthday parties and dances.

The club has been running for over 30 years and should be able to cover the running costs. It was noted in last years application that funding would only last for a restricted time but that the club have been sent information about East Ayrshire Sports Council and other sources of funding which would allow money to be freed up to meet these costs.
