#### "MAKE OUR COMMUNITIES SAFER" CHALLENGE COMPETITION 2001/2002- COMMUNITY SAFETY PROJECTS

##### Report by Director of Community Services

### 1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

- 1.1 To advise the Committee of the outcome of the bids for funding made in respect of proposed Community safety projects in East Ayrshire.

### 2. BACKGROUND

- 2.1 As in previous years, the Council made bids for funding through the "Make our Communities Safer" Challenge Competition administered by the Scottish Executive.
- 2.2 Five bids were prepared in respect of Community Safety projects and submitted to the Scottish Executive in October 2000 in the name of the Community Safety Forum. The bids were in respect of :-
- (i) Kilmarnock South Outreach and Detached Youth work with Vulnerable People project.
  - (ii) Positive Diversions for under 16s. (iii) Caring or Carers project.
  - (iv) Safe Barshare Community Initiative.
  - (v) Yipworld.com Detached Streetworkers Initiative.
- 2.3 The cost of the projects described above was estimated at £251,139.20 and the total amount bid for was £105,833.17.

### 3. DISCUSSION

- 3.1 In letters dated early February 2001 the Scottish Executive, Justice Department advised that the bids in respect of Positive Diversions for under 16s and Yipworld.com Detached Streetworkers Initiative had been successful and that that the other three bids had not. The lead Departments for the projects are Educational and Social Services and the Social Inclusion Partnership supported by Community Education.
- 3.2 The table below sets out the costs of the successful projects and identifies the funding sources.
