1 PURPOSE OF REPORT

- 1.1 The purpose of this report is to outline applications for financial assistance under the Awards to Bands Scheme for the Committee's consideration.

2 BACKGROUND

- 2.1 The Awards to Bands Scheme is administered by the Community Services Department and considers applications from bands based in the East Ayrshire area.
- 2.2 Bands which receive an award are obliged to complete a performance agreement which confirms their availability to provide up to three performances for East Ayrshire Council per annum, if asked.
