**FINAL MEASUREMENT – SUPPLY AND INSTALLATION OF DISPLAY
CASES AT THE DICK INSTITUTE, KILMARNOCK**

1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

- 1.1 The purpose of this report is to provide information on final measurements for the contract to supply and install display cases at the Dick Institute, Kilmarnock.

2. BACKGROUND/CONSIDERATIONS

- 2.1 The tender for the above project was accepted on 9 October 1996 for work to be carried out by East Ayrshire Building and Works.

- 2.2 The final measurement for the contract is as follows:-

Accepted tender	£43,278.00
Amount of final certificate	<u>£43,452.12</u>
Contract Overspend	£ 174.12

- 2.3 The above represents an overspend of £174.12 which is due to acceleration costs due to time constraints.

3. FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

- 3.1 All costs were met from existing budgets.
