1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

- 1.1 To invite the Committee to declare the former Grounds Maintenance DSO bothy and tool shed sited at Wardneuk Drive, Kilmarnock surplus to requirements.

2. DISCUSSION

- 2.1 The bothy/tool shed at Wardneuk Drive was used by the Grounds Maintenance DSO to assist with the delivery of Service in the north area of Kilmarnock. The DSO now operates this service from the depot at Western Road, Kilmarnock and as such the bothy is now surplus to requirements.
