**PROPOSED DISPOSAL OF FORMER GLAISNOCK OUTDOOR
CENTRE, BY CUMNOCK**

2. There was submitted a joint report dated 8 October 2001 (circulated) by the Director of Development Services and the Solicitor to the Council which advised of the outcome of the recent marketing of the former Glaisnock Outdoor Centre and associated grounds as shown on the plan appended to the report and sought authority to dispose of the subjects, subject to the consent of the Scottish Executive in terms of Section 74(2) of the Local Government (Scotland) Act 1973.

It was agreed:

- (i) to authorise the Solicitor to the Council to accept the offer received for the former Glaisnock Outdoor Centre, by Cumnock from George Glover and Partners subject to the conditions outlined in paragraph 10 of the report and the consent of the Scottish Executive in terms of Section 74(2) of the Local Government (Scotland) Act 1973; and
- (ii) otherwise to note the report.

Councillor Coffey, having moved an alternative proposal in respect of continuation of this item, which failed to receive a seconder, registered his dissent to this decision.

The meeting terminated at 1516 hrs.
