**REMOVAL OF ASBESTOS AT DOON ACADEMY,  
AYR ROAD, DALMELLINGTON (Item 3, Page 2566, 99/02)**

2. There was submitted a joint report (circulated) by the Directors of Homes and Technical Services and of Educational and Social Services which advised of the discovery of further asbestos material at Doon Academy during the course of the initial asbestos removal works, and the resultant additional costs.

It was agreed:

- (i) to approve the actions taken to date in respect of the asbestos removal works and to approve the expenditure incurred; and
- (ii) otherwise to note the contents of the report.

**REINSTATEMENT WORKS FOLLOWING THE REMOVAL OF ASBESTOS  
AT DOON ACADEMY, AYR ROAD, DALMELLINGTON**

3. There was submitted a joint report dated 11 June 2002 (circulated) by the Directors of Homes and Technical Services and of Educational and Social Services which advised of the nature and anticipated cost of reinstatement works at Doon Academy following on from the asbestos removal operation which was currently being undertaken, and which sought authority to negotiate the contract for the reinstatement works.

It was agreed:

- (i) to approve the action taken to date including the hire of additional classroom units;
- (ii) in terms of Standing Order 10(2) relating to contracts, to approve the negotiation of the tender for the reinstatement works at Doon Academy, Dalmellington with Central Building Contractors (Glasgow) Ltd, in accordance with established benchmarking criteria, and subject to the agreement of satisfactory timescales and rates for the works; and
- (iii) otherwise to note the contents of the report.
