CONSIDERATION OF PLANNING APPLICATION

1. APPLICATION NO 01/0387/FL: PROPOSED CHANGE OF USE FROM STORAGE WAREHOUSE TO FORM NEW COMMERCIAL OFFICE PREMISES AND EXTENSION OF EXISTING BUILDING AT 36 GRANGE STREET, KILMARNOCK

There was submitted an executive summary sheet and report dated 6 February 2002 (circulated) by the Head of Planning and Building Control on a full planning application for proposed change of use for a storage warehouse to form new commercial office premises and extension of existing building at 36 Grange Street, Kilmarnock.

The Senior Planning Officer reported that one letter of objection had been received, details of which were contained within the report; summarised the planning considerations in respect of the application and gave the recommendation of the Head of Planning and Building Control: Approval, subject to the conditions, and for the reasons detailed, in the report.

No Hearing took place as the objector was not present or represented.

It was agreed to approve the application (a) subject to the conditions, and for the reasons detailed, in the report; and (b) subject to incorporating additional conditions regarding a reduction in the height of the car park wall and provision of adequate illumination of the car park access area.
