**PROPOSED DISPOSAL OF FORMER GLAISNOCK OUTDOOR CENTRE  
BY CUMNOCK**

2. There was submitted a joint report dated 4 April 2001 (circulated) by the Director of Development Services and the Solicitor to the Council which updated the Committee in respect of the proposed disposal of the former Glaisnock Outdoor Centre, by Cumnock, to Education and Care Developments Ltd, and which sought instructions.

It was agreed:

- (i) to authorise the Solicitor to the Council to agree to the extension to the date of entry in respect of the proposed disposal of the former Glaisnock Outdoor Centre, by Cumnock to the Education and Care Development Co Ltd to 30 April 2001 in the terms proposed in the report;
- (ii) that in the event of settlement arrangements not being concluded, to authorise the Solicitor to the Council to exercise the Council's option to resile from the bargain and authorise the Director of Development Services to re-market the property; and
- (iii) otherwise to note the contents of the report.
