**BOUNDARY COMMISSION FOR SCOTLAND - FIFTH PERIODICAL REVIEW OF  
PARLIAMENTARY CONSTITUENCIES - SCOTLAND (Item 7, Page 2427, 99/03)**

1. There was submitted a report dated 3 September 2002 (circulated) by the Chief Executive which informed of the proposed public inquiry to be held on 11, 12 and 13 September 2002 associated with the Boundary Commission's Review of Parliamentary Constituencies in Scotland; confirmed Council representation at the public inquiry; and sought approval of a name for the Council's alternative Parliamentary Constituency covering the existing Kilmarnock and Loudoun Parliamentary Constituency and part of the existing Carrick, Cumnock and Doon Valley Parliamentary Constituency.

It was agreed:

- (i) to suggest at the local inquiry that the Council's alternative Parliamentary Constituency covering the existing Kilmarnock and Loudoun Parliamentary Constituency and part of the existing Carrick, Cumnock and Doon Valley Parliamentary Constituency be named Kilmarnock, Loudoun and Auchinleck Parliamentary Constituency;

Councillor Wilson, having moved an alternative proposal which failed to receive a seconder, recorded his dissent to this decision.

- (ii) to request that the suggested amended Parliamentary Constituency of Ayr, New Cumnock and Cumnock be named Ayr, Carrick and Cumnock Parliamentary Constituency;
- (iii) that the Head of Administration and Legal Services/Solicitor to the Council together with the Administration Manager represent the Council at the forthcoming public local inquiry; and
- (iii) otherwise to note the report.

Provost Jimmy Boyd joined the meeting during consideration of 1(i) above.
