RE-ALIGNMENT OF EDUCATION SERVICES CAPITAL PROGRAMME 2003/04

1. There was submitted a report dated 30 June 2003 (circulated) by the Director of Educational and Social Services which sought agreement to a proposed re-alignment of the Education Capital Programme for 2003/04.

It was agreed:-

- (i) to the proposed re-alignment of the Education Capital Programme spending for 2003/04, as detailed in Appendix 1 of the report; and

SCOTLAND-BELGIUM CULTURAL CONNECTION

2. There was submitted a report dated 30 June 2003 (circulated) by the Depute Chief Executive/Director of Corporate Resources which asked the Committee (i) to consider a request from the Scotland-Belgium Cultural Connection to host a Civic Reception on 13 August 2003, (ii) to consider assistance with the costs associated with group visitor entry to the Dean Castle and (iii) to meet the costs of the hall let for the final evening dinner dance to be held in Kilmaurs Community Centre on 16 August 2003.

It was agreed:-

- (i) to host a Civic Reception on 13 August 2003 for the Scotland-Belgium Cultural Connection;
- (ii) to provide financial assistance with the cost of the hall let for the final evening dinner dance up to a maximum of £160.00;
- (iii) to note that the initially requested financial assistance with the cost associated with group visit entry to the Dean Castle was not now required as the visit would take place during working hours, incurring no cost;
- (iv) to remit the necessary arrangements to the Depute Chief Executive/Director of Corporate Resources in consultation with the Chair; and
- (v) otherwise, to note the report.
