

STRATHCLYDE POLICE
PERFORMANCE REPORT
APRIL - DECEMBER 2000

Overall crime has increased in the first nine months of the year by 12.4%, which equates to 245 more crimes. This however incorporates a 44% increase (91 crimes) in drug related offences which are pro-actively initiated.

The above figures are broken down into the following categories:-

Crimes of violence	down 19%	from 474 to 383
Crimes of indecency	down 26%	from 53 to 39
Crimes of dishonesty	up 15%	from 1,019 to 1,177
• Housebreakings	up 18%	from 329 to 389
• Vehicle Crime	up 6%	from 206 to 218
• Other Dishonesties	up 8%	from 484 to 570
Crimes of vandalism	up 10%	from 411 to 453
Drug related crimes	up 44%	from 206 to 297

Disorder related issues are down 25%, which is in no small way due to the focused and target driven initiatives that have been carried out throughout the Cumnock and Doon Valley area in the year to date.

The detection rate for the area is 53.1% compared to a Force detection rate of 43.7%
