QUESTIONS ARISING FROM 15 MINUTE QUESTION AND ANSWER SESSION

<u>MATTER RAISED</u>	<u>RESPONSE/ACTION TO BE TAKEN</u>
<p>Mr Arthur Burley, member of the public, enquired as to progress towards repair of the boiler within Auchinleck Community Centre bearing in mind that the heating system within the Centre had not been operational for a number of weeks.</p>	<p>Councillor Menzies advised that a delay in effecting a repair was due to the need for a replacement "worm shaft" to be manufactured from scratch. The Councillor, however, expressed the hope that it would be possible for this part to be obtained and a repair to the heating system carried out as soon as possible.</p>
<p>Community Representative Mr William Lees drew attention to the need for a repair to a manhole at a location on the A76 within New Cumnock and enquired as to the arrangements for reporting this matter. Mr Lees also drew attention to a similar problem at a location within the B741 route, near New Cumnock.</p>	<p>Provost Boyd advised that responsibility for maintenance of trunk roads lies with the contractor AMEY. It was agreed that the Administrative Officer would liaise with Mr Lees with a view to obtaining details of the precise location of the repair needed to the A76 in order that this might be reported to the contractor; and of the repair needed on the B741 in order that this might be referred to the Council's Roads Section for attention.</p>
