### 7. STREET NAMING

- 7.1 OCHILTREE: DEVELOPMENT AT WATSON FARM** - The Committee are invited to determine a street name for a new private housing development at Watson Farm, Ochiltree.

(Note: The Local Elected Member and Ochiltree Community Council have suggested the street name "Highfield Place", since the area in which the housing development is to take place is known locally as the "High Road").

- 7.2 CATRINE: DEVELOPMENT AT MAUCHLINE ROAD** - The Committee are invited to determine street names for a private housing development comprising three new streets located off Mauchline Road, Catrine.

(Note: The Local Elected Member has suggested the following names for the three streets, namely:-

Street 1 - Burnpark (this is the local name for the area in which the whole development is taking place);

Street 2 - Ballochmyle View (Ballochmyle Woods lie immediately to the north west of the development site); and

Street 3 - Burn O'Need Way (The Burn O'Need runs along the north west boundary of the development site).

Catrine Community Council have suggested the following names for the three streets, namely:-

Street 1 - McCrae View (in respect of Doctor John McCrae, a retired GP who provided service as a GP to the community of Catrine for a large number of years and who previously resided in Mauchline Road, Catrine);

Street 2 - Cowan Place (historically - Pre-1930's - an area of Mauchline Road in Catrine was called Cowan Place); and

Street 3 - Jacob's Wynd (the Community Council took the view that this street approximately gives access to Jacob's Ladder which is a set of steps leading up to the slope from the Burn O'Need at the rear of the development site into the Ballochmyle Estate)).
