**QUESTIONS ARISING FROM 15 MINUTE QUESTION AND ANSWER SESSION**

<b><u>MATTER RAISED</u></b>	<b><u>ACTION TO BE TAKEN</u></b>
<p>Mr William Crawford expressed concern regarding the playing of golf and the riding of motorcycles on maintained open spaces and at Broomfield/Woodroad Park.</p>	<p>Chief Inspector McKnight indicated that those individuals indulging in such activities within confined areas (for example at maintained open spaces within housing areas) or at areas with signs clearly indicating, for example, "No Golf" could be open to a charge of "reckless conduct". Should the public have any concerns about such activities, these should be reported to the local Police Office.</p> <p>Local Community Councils (a) if they consider it appropriate, to raise this matter with the press in order to publicise the potential danger of the activities referred to; and (b) to make representations to Denis Craig, Principal Officer (Recreation) within the Department of Community Services in respect of areas where they consider it would be appropriate for signs to be erected which would prohibit a specific activity, for example, golf.</p>
