<u>MATTER RAISED</u>	<u>RESPONSE/ACTION TO BE TAKEN</u>
<p>Mr Burley, member of the public, enquired as to the extent of deployment of Community Policing within the area.</p>	<p>Chief Inspector McKnight advised that resources permitting, Community Police Officers were deployed across all communities within the Cumnock Area and their duties were recently changed to be aligned with the traditional shift pattern of operation. It was acknowledged that unfortunately, Community Councils were informed after the change of the shift patterns had taken place. However, it was confirmed that the Community Policing Pilot Project would be evaluated in November and with a final assessment in February 2002. It was confirmed that Community Councils would be involved in the consultation.</p>
