SUMMARY OF MAJOR POINTS OF OBJECTION TO BE ADDRESSED AT PUBLIC LOCAL INQUIRY

- (i) Methodology used in identifying Potential Coal Extraction Areas too simplistic and overly restrictive
- (ii) Identified Potential Coal Extraction Areas too restricted / too extensive
- (iii) 500 metre buffer zones around settlements too onerous / not large enough
- (iv) More / less operations should be permitted in 500 metre buffer zones
- (v) Level of contributions to Minerals Trust Fund too high / too low
- (vi) Restoration policy too prescriptive and simplistic
