OUTSTANDING OBJECTIONS TO LOCAL PLAN

AND

OBJECTIONS RECEIVED IN RESPECT OF AGREED MODIFICATIONS

Report by Director of Development Services

1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 To inform the Committee of those objections received in respect of the finalised version of the East Ayrshire Local Plan which remain outstanding and unresolved; to inform the Committee of the formal objections and representations received in respect of the modifications made to the finalised version of the Local Plan; to inform the Committee of the Department's assessment of each objection received in respect of the modifications and to seek authorisation from the Committee to forward a copy of the remaining outstanding and unresolved objections to the Local Plan and a copy of the objections received in respect of the modifications made to the Local Plan to the Scottish Executive Inquiry Reporters Unit for consideration at any future Public Local Inquiry into the Local Plan which may require to be arranged at a future date.

2. BACKGROUND INFORMATION

2.1 At its meeting on 15 February 2001 the Council authorised the Head of Planning and Building Control to advertise a series of agreed modifications to the East Ayrshire Local Plan and this was carried out during the week commencing 19 February 2001. It was also agreed to enter into negotiation/discussion with individual objectors with regard to objections already made or with regard to any future objections received in respect of the modifications advertised. This process is ongoing and the results of these exercises to date form the subject of this report.

3. OUTSTANDING OBJECTIONS

3.1 Following advertisement of the Local Plan in December 1999, 709 responses were received by the Department encompassing a total of 230 separate points of objection. Ongoing discussion and negotiation with individual objectors has left, to date, a total of 38 objections from 41 respondents to be

determined by Public Local Inquiry and 73 objections from 27 respondents to be determined by written representations. A table summarising the remaining unresolved objections to be addressed at a Public Local Inquiry is attached to this report as ANNEX 1 and a summary of those unresolved objections to be dealt with by written representations is appended as ANNEX 2. A total of 603 objectors to the Local Plan have given no indication to the Council as to how they wish their objections to be progressed and these will be forwarded to the Scottish Executive Inquiry Reporters Unit for assessment against the Council's responses as previously agreed by Committee.

3.2 The majority of outstanding objections to be addressed relate to specific Housing Development Opportunity Sites identified in the plan, the main ones being:-

- Objections to the inclusion of Belvedere View, Galston.
- Objections to the inclusion of Standalane, Kilmaurs.
- Objections to the inclusion of Galston Road, Hurlford.
- Objections to the inclusion of Waterslap, Fenwick.

Other objections relate to the non-inclusion of certain suggested housing sites, the principle of these being:-

- Objections to the non-inclusion of Treesbank, Kilmarnock.

3.3 The main outstanding objections pertaining to policy matters relate to the following subjects:-

- the non-inclusion of opencast coal related matters in the plan.
- waste disposal matters pertaining to landfill.
- retailing matters relating to Queens Drive and North Kilmarnock.

4. OBJECTIONS TO MODIFICATIONS

4.1 Following advertisement of the Modifications to the Local Plan in February 2001, a total of 9 points of objection from 14 respondents was received. A list of objections to the modifications, together with a suggested Council response on each objection received has been produced as ANNEX 3 to the report. Copies of ANNEX 3 have been placed in the Members Lounge and circulated to Group Leaders accordingly. The suggested response assesses the relevance of the point to each previously agreed Council policy and does not alter the Council's position.

4.2 The main objections to the modifications relate to the following subjects:-

- the inclusion of housing site at Old Glasgow Road, Stewarton.
- the redrafting of the Hurlford & Crookedholm boundaries.

- the revised Motorway Service Area Policy
- the deletion of housing site at Dalry Road, Stewarton
- the inclusion of All Seasons site at Galston.
- the reduced number of housing sites at Galston.

5. THE WAY FORWARD

5.1 Should the Council agree to the suggested response to each objection received in respect of the advertised modifications as detailed in ANNEX 3 of the report, it is proposed that the following steps be initiated in order to progress the Local Plan to adoption:-

- (i) to arrange a Public Local Inquiry to consider any unresolved objections to both the Finalised Version of the Local Plan and the agreed modifications
- (ii) to forward copies of the unresolved objections and the objections to the agreed modifications, together with the Council's views on each as detailed in Annex 1, 2 and 3 of this report, to the Scottish Executive Inquiry Reporters Unit for information and action
- (iii) to consider any recommendations made by the Reporter at the Public Local Inquiry
- (iv) to adopt the Local Plan

6. FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

6.1 Costs will be incurred by the Department in providing a suitable venue for the Public Local Inquiry, in providing an appropriate Programmes Officer to assist the Reporter in conducting the Inquiry and in paying for the services of the Reporter. Such costs will be met from existing budgets.

7. LEGAL/AUTHORITY IMPLICATIONS

7.1 The Division may require legal representation at the Public Local Inquiry to assist in presenting the Council's case.

8. PERSONNEL IMPLICATIONS

8.1 The Public Local Inquiry will require inter-departmental working, especially between the Planning and Building Control Division and the Council's Legal Section, and the appointment or secondment of a suitable Inquiry Programmes Officer for the period of the Inquiry. This will place a significant burden on manpower which will require other work to be managed accordingly.

9. POLICY IMPLICATIONS

9.1 No further policy modifications are proposed and therefore there are no policy implications.

10. RECOMMENDATION

10.1 It is recommended that the Committee agrees:-

- (i) to authorise the Head of Planning and Building Control to make any necessary supplementary comment and observation, as required and considered appropriate, on the unresolved objections to the Local Plan, prior to their being forwarded to the Scottish Executive Inquiry Reporters Unit, as recommended in (iii) below;**
- (ii) to approve the suggested Council response to the objections received to the modifications to the Local Plan, as detailed in ANNEX 3 to this report;**
- (iii) to forward copies of all unresolved objections to the Local Plan (summarised in ANNEXES 1 and 2 to this report) together with copies of the objections received to the modifications and the Council's response to the objections (as detailed in ANNEX 3 to this report) to the Scottish Executive Inquiry Reporters Unit for information and action; and**
- (iv) to otherwise note the contents of the report.**
