GRANTS TO EXTERNAL BODIES AND PARTNERSHIPS – 2001/2002

Report by Director of Development Services

1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

- 1.1 To seek Committee approval for grants to external bodies for 2001/02.

2. PROPOSED PAYMENTS

- 2.1.1 It is proposed to continue to make grants to all except one of the external bodies falling within the remit of Development Services at the same level as 2000/01 subject to minor changes to reflect inflation (at 3.3%) and changes in scales of fees recommended by the organisations supported. The proposed levels of payment are set out in the attached schedule.
- 2.2 The only significant change proposed is a reduction of £30,000 to £210,000 in the grant to the East Ayrshire Employment Initiative. The Initiative currently has a balance in excess of operating requirements. The other rationale for this deduction is that the Initiative was charged by the Council with earning funds from other sources, which they have done, thereby reducing their dependency on Council funding and will not have an impact on service delivery.

3. FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

- 3.1 The payments listed can be met from the approved budget.

4. LEGAL IMPLICATIONS

5. RECOMMENDATION

5.1 It is recommended that the Committee:

- (a) approve the grants to other bodies for 2001/2002 set out in the attached table;

and

- (b) authorise the Director to make minor adjustments reflecting the basis on which grants have previously been agreed.
