COMMENTS:- The group is open to all residents aged 50 and over residing in Dalrymple area. The group currently has 40 members. The group was founded in 1979 and their main aim is to provide social and educational opportunities for the inhabitants of the Dalrymple area. The Assessing Department (Educational and Social Services) have recommended a grant of £300 as the group have a healthy bank balance and could contribute more to the overall costs of the activities.

COMMENTS:- The group have restarted Guides after an 18 month gap. At present the group have 9-10 members with an average attendance of nine. The age range for the Guides is 10-15 years. The group have requested the grant which they state will help the Guides to be in uniform and to allow the guides to participate in various outings to help their social skills. The grant will also go towards materials and equipment needed for badge work.

The Assessing Department (Educational and Social Services) have recommended a grant of £500. It will provide an educational/development programme for local children and provide access to new training materials and a structured badgework programme not previously available in Patna.

The group have recently received a grant of £2,000 from the Minerals Trust which will contribute to clothing and materials. This grant will fund trips and educational activities.
