RECRUITMENT OF COMMUNITY REPRESENTATIVES 2001/2002

Report by the Depute Chief Executive/Director of Corporate Resources

1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

- 1.1** To request the Committee to complete the selection of local organisations to be invited to nominate Community Representatives and Named Substitutes to serve on the Local Committee for the period 1 April 2001 to 31 March 2002.

2. BACKGROUND

- 2.1** The Local Committee at their meeting on 30 January 2001 agreed as follows:-

- (i) to note the present community membership as detailed in the report;
- (ii) that the organisational sectors be:- Drongan Community Council; Dalmellington Community Council; Patna Community Council; Dalrymple Community Council; Rankinston Community Association/Rankinston Old People's Welfare Association (Joint Nomination); Bellsbank Women's Project; East Ayrshire (South) Forum on Disability; Pupils' Representative (Dalmellington/Patna/Dalrymple); and Pupils' Representative (Drongan/Rankinston);
- (iii) that the Depute Chief Executive/Director of Corporate Resources invite the above organisations to submit nominations for community membership for the period to 31 March 2002; and
- (iv) that in respect of the final organisational place, the Depute Chief Executive/Director of Corporate Resources contact the following organisations to ascertain whether they would be interested in nominating a Community Representative and Substitute, and report to the next meeting of this Committee:- Peer Education Group; and Drongan Community Association.

3. PRESENT POSITION

- 3.1** The organisations selected by the Committee have been requested to nominate Community Representatives and Substitutes for the period 1 April 2001 to 31 March 2002 and a report will be submitted to the next meeting of this Committee on the nominations received.

3.2 With respect to the final organisational place, both the Peer Education Group and Drongan Community Association have confirmed that they would be interested in nominating a Community Representative and Substitute to serve on the Local Committee.

5. RECOMMENDATIONS

5.1 It is recommended that the Local Committee:-

- (i) note the present position with respect to the nomination of Community Representatives and Named Substitutes; and
- (ii) consider the selection of a local organisation to be invited to appoint a Community Representative and Substitute in order to fill the final organisational place on the Local Committee.
