RECRUITMENT OF COMMUNITY REPRESENTATIVES 2002/2003

1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

- 1.1** To advise the Local Committee on the outcome of recruitment of Community Representatives and Substitutes to serve on the Doon Valley Local Committee for the period commencing 1 April 2002 to 31 March 2003.

2. BACKGROUND

- 2.1** The Council's Decentralisation Scheme makes provision for Local Committees to involve the local community in the decision-making process by inviting appropriate local organisations to nominate up to 10 representatives to serve on the Local Committee as Community Representatives, together with Named Substitutes.
- 2.2** The Doon Valley Local Committee at the meeting held on 28 January 2002, agreed that Community Representatives would liaise with their Community Organisations on the submission of nominations for Community Representation (Community Representatives and Named Substitutes) on the Doon Valley Local Committee for the period of one year commencing 1 April 2002 to 31 March 2003.

3. PRESENT POSITION

- 3.1** Community Organisations have submitted nominations for Community Representatives and Named Substitutes as detailed in the appendix to this report.
- 3.2** Patna Community Council have intimated that for the period 1 April 2002 to 31 March 2003 they are not nominating a Community Representative or Named Substitute to represent the Community Council on the Doon Valley Local Committee.

4. FINANCIAL/LEGAL/POLICY IMPLICATIONS - Nil.

5. RECOMMENDATIONS

- 5.1** It is recommended to approve the new nominations for Community Membership to the Doon Valley Local Committee by the relevant organisations, as detailed in the appendix to this report for the period 1 April 2002 to 31 March 2003.

- 5.2** It is recommended that the Local Committee consider whether Patna Community Council be excluded as a nominating organisation on the Doon Valley Local Committee and also consider including another organisational sector for the period 1 April 2002 to 31 March 2003.
