1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

- 1.1 To advise the Committee of the re-establishment of the rank of Police Sergeant at Dalmellington.

2. DISCUSSION

- 2.1 The Chief Constable has recently announced his intention to re-establish the rank of Police Sergeant on a full time basis in the Dalmellington Police section.
- 2.2 The appointment to this post will be made by autumn 2000 following a full review by the Divisional Commander to identify a suitable officer to fill this demanding and challenging post.
- 2.3 With the development and imminent completion of the multi-agency accommodation and the establishment of a community safety group in Dalmellington the re-establishment of a Sergeant's post at Dalmellington will contribute significantly to crime prevention, crime reduction and community safety in the Doon Valley.
