<b>ISSUE RAISED</b>	<b>RESPONSE/ACTION REQUIRED</b>	<b>CURRENT POSITION</b>
Community Representative Mr Tony Foote raised the issue of the bus route between Ayr and Rankinston. He advised that on occasions, the bus had driven past Rankinston without collecting passengers, and that drivers were not following the routes shown on the timetable.	It was agreed to write a general complaint, highlighting Mr Foote's issue, to SPT. A copy of the letter to be sent to Mr Foote and Councillor Farrell.	Letter sent to Strathclyde Passenger Transport from Councillor Stewart on Thursday 20 November 2003. Copies sent to Councillor Farrell and Mr Tony Foote.  Fax received from SPT on 2 December advising that arrangements were made to raise the concerns at a meeting with the Operator on 4 December 2003.
Community Representative Mr Edward Torrance raised the issue of the grass verges at Coalhall and their non-reinstatement to date by Scottish Power.	It was agreed to advise the Head of Roads and Transportation of this issue.	Email sent to John Bryson 12 November 2003 advising of the issue and requesting that a response be sent directly to Mr Torrance.  Letter sent to Mr Torrance 24 November 2003 advising that Scottish Power were awaiting the delivery of apparatus required for the new sub-station at Coalhall.
