1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

- 1.1 To advise members of the Scottish Accident Prevention Council's (SAPC) 53rd Annual Conference.

2. BACKGROUND

- 2.1 The Council is a member of SAPC and has member and officer representation on each of its three committees, viz:- Road Safety, Water and Leisure Safety and Home Safety. Councillor Jimmy Carmichael currently is Vice-Chair of the Water and Leisure Safety Committee.

3. DISCUSSION

- 3.1 This year's conference will take place on Monday 9th and Tuesday 10th September 2002 at Crieff Hydro. Incorporated into the conference programme, as in previous years, will be core sessions for all delegates combined with parallel sessions during which delegates may concentrate on specific home, road, or water and leisure safety issues.

- 4.1 The full delegate fee for the conference is £210 which includes all meals and one night's accommodation. Attendance for one day only would cost £70, including lunch.
