<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Pothole and other minor repairs to roads and footways within housing schemes, local centres and heavily used roads between communities.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Potholes and disintegration of road edges has become a frequent complaint by members of the public.</li> <li>• Fundamental safety action</li> <li>• Reduced public liability claims</li> </ul>
