### RECRUITMENT OF COMMUNITY REPRESENTATIVES 2001/2002

#### Report by the Depute Chief Executive/Director of Corporate Resources

#### 1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

- 1.1 To advise of the position in respect of the appointment of Community Representatives of local organisations to serve on the Irvine Valley Local Committee for the period from 1 April 2001 to 31 March 2002.

#### 2. BACKGROUND

- 2.1 The Irvine Valley Local Committee at its meeting on 7 February 2001 agreed to remit to the Depute Chief Executive/Director of Corporate Resources to initiate the process for the submission of new nominations for Community Representatives and Named Substitutes by the relevant organisations, to serve during the period 1 April 2001 to 31 March 2002 and to make such arrangements as might be necessary to facilitate this process.
- 2.2 As Members are aware, the Local Committee agreed to retain the current community organisation representation on the Local Committee, namely:-
- (a) five members from the appropriate Community Councils;
  - (b) one member from the appropriate Elderly Interest Groups;
  - (c) one member from the Disability Forum;
  - (d) one member from the Youth Forum (or equivalent organisation);
  - (e) one member from Pre-5's Interest Groups; and
  - (f) one member from Crookedholm Community Association.

#### 3. APPOINTMENTS FOR 2001/2002: CURRENT POSITION
