QUESTIONS ARISING FROM 15 MINUTE QUESTION AND ANSWER SESSION

MATTER RAISED	ACTION TO BE TAKEN
Substitute Frank Donnelly requested information on the start date for traffic calming works in the east end of Darvel.	Referred to the table in the Local Transport Strategy (circulated) which detailed the proposed measures here. Advise the Head of Roads and Transportation to write to Mr Donnelly when measures and start date are finalised.
Substitute Frank Donnelly asked for an explanation on the length of time taken to repair a streetlamp in Jamieson Road, Darvel despite being reported several times.	Refer this matter to the Head of Roads and Transportation with a letter advising Mr Donnelly.
Councillor McDill referred to a letter he had received seeking support for upgraded toilet facilities at Hurlford Adult Training Centre.	Noted that Councillor Raymond had passed his copy of this letter to the Chief executive for his attention together with his comments.
Councillor Wilson referred to the Senior Citizens Cabin in Newmilns where the upgrading of the ramp and toilets for wheelchair users was being sought. Community Representative Nancy Mair reported on the letter/photos she had sent recently to the Council on this matter.	Agreed that Councillor Raymond and Councillor Wilson would visit the premises. Meanwhile the Administration Manager and the Director of Educational and Social Services would investigate and respond to Nancy Mair/Harry Wilson.
Community Representative Evelyn Mair pointed out that there was no safety flooring at the play area in Burnhouse Walk, Galston.	Refer this matter to the Director of Community Services for investigation and response to Evelyn Mair.
Community Representative Evelyn Mair complained that there was no litter bin facility now at the bus-stop/car park at Loudoun Road/Kilnholm Street, Newmilns.	Refer matter to the Director of Community Services for investigation and response to Evelyn Mair.
Community Representative Andrew Nisbet enquired whether the burn at Richardson Park, Hurlford could be cleared of rubbish. If it wasn't this caused flooding to adjacent fields and was also potentially dangerous to children.	Refer this matter to the Director of Community Services for investigation and response to Andrew Nisbet.
Community Representative Nancy Mair reported a slippery pavement at Brewland Street, Galston outside the former co-op building (moss and bird droppings)	Refer this to the Director of Community Services for investigation and response to Nancy Mair. Director of Community Services to provide details of Department responsibilities and how street cleaning is prioritised.
