QUESTIONS ARISING FROM 15 MINUTE QUESTION AND ANSWER SESSION

<u>MATTERS RAISED</u>	<u>ACTION TO BE TAKEN</u>	<u>OUTCOME</u>
Community Representative Steve Brown inquired about progress in clearing council house gutters in West Church Street, Newmilns	Area Housing Manager reported that the programme had started, and that West Church Street houses were on this. The programme should be completed beginning of October.	The Committee also agreed to receive a report at the next meeting on the progress regarding clearing of gutters of council houses in Irvine Valley.
Community Representative Jessie Graham raised 2 issues in relation to grass cutting/maintenance. (1) grass cuttings not being lifted generally and in particular at Mauchline Road/Galloway Row the cuttings were blowing on to the pavement and road and (2) areas of "waste ground" cut once a year and needing more. Two sites mentioned were (i) garage site at Academy Street, Mauchline Road, Hurlford and (ii) garage site at rear of houses at Riccarton Park, Hurlford.	Agreed to advise Director of Community Services of these issues and report back on the outcome.	
Community Representative Bill Howie reported continual burning of rubbish at site at Galston Road, Hurlford.	Agreed to pass this matter on to Environmental Health Service.
