**STREET NAMING - GLENFIELD BOWLING CLUB, OFF QUEENS DRIVE,
KILMARNOCK**

Report by Director of Corporate Resources/Depute Chief Executive

1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

- 1.1 To advise the Local Committee of two new streets off Queens Drive, Kilmarnock and to request the Local Committee's view on proposed names for the two streets in question.

2. BACKGROUND

- 2.1 The Decentralisation Sub-Committee of the Policy and Resources Committee, at its meeting on 4 June 1996 (Item 3, Page 968) (subsequently approved by the Policy and Resources Committee of 13 June 1996), agreed that the naming of streets be included within the remit of Local Committees.
- 2.2 The procedure to be adopted in respect of the naming of streets involves notifying the Local Member and the local Community Council for suggestions, prior to consideration by the Local Committee. Correspondence in respect of this matter was duly sent to Councillor Alex Walsh, as the Local Member, and to Piersland Bentinck Community Council.

3. CURRENT PROPOSAL

- 3.1 Following consultation with the local Elected Member, Piersland Bentinck Community Council submitted the suggestion that the street from Victoria Roundabout to the new small roundabout to be built, be called Victoria East Road, and the street from the new roundabout to the Bowling Club be called Glenfield Way.

5. LEGAL AUTHORITY/IMPLICATIONS

- 5.1 Section 97 of the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982 gives authority to East Ayrshire Council in relation to the naming of streets and the preparation of house numbers, etc.

7.1 The Local Committee is asked:-

- (i) to consider the naming of the two streets in question; and
- (ii) that the Head of Technical Services be advised of the outcome.
