1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

- 1.1 The request the Committee to consider names for one street within a new development at Glebe Road, Kilmarnock.

2. BACKGROUND

- 2.1 The Decentralisation Sub-Committee of the Policy and Resources Committee at its meeting on 4 June 1996 agreed that the naming of streets be included within the remit of Local Committees.
- 2.2 Section 97 of the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982 gives authority to East Ayrshire Council in relation to naming of street and the preparation of house numbers etc.
- 2.3 The Local Member, Councillor Lilian MacLean and Piersland/Bentinck Community Council have both been informed of the development and have been requested to put forward suggestions on the name of the street to this Committee.

- 3.1 Councillor Lilian MacLean, in consultation with Piersland/Bentinck Community Council has suggested the name Glebe Court.
