### **NAMING OF STREETS BY LOCAL COMMITTEES - DEVELOPMENT AT IRVINE ROAD, CROSSHOUSE**

#### **Report by Depute Chief Executive/Director of Corporate Resources**

#### **1. PURPOSE OF REPORT**

- 1.1 To request the Committee to consider naming a street within a new development at Irvine Road, Crosshouse.

#### **2. BACKGROUND**

- 2.1 The Decentralisation Sub-Committee of the Policy and Resources Committee at its meeting on 4 June 1996 agreed that the naming of streets be included within the remit of the Local Committees.
- 2.2 Section 97 of the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982 gives authority to East Ayrshire Council in relation to naming of streets and the preparation of house numbers etc.
- 2.3 The Local Member, Councillor Brian Reeves and Crosshouse Community Council have both been informed of the development and have been requested to put forward suggestions on the name of the street to this Committee.

#### **3. CURRENT POSITION**

- 3.1 Crosshouse Community Council in consultation with Councillor Brian Reeves have suggested the name Fisher Way.
- 3.2 The developer has asked that "Craufurdhill Gardens" be considered for the street within the above development.

#### **5. RECOMMENDATIONS**

##### **5.1 It is recommended:-**

- (i) that the Committee name the street within the new development at Irvine Road, Crosshouse; and
