MATTER RAISED	ACTION TAKEN
Community Representative Robert Jones expressed concern about dog fouling at Glen Lyon Crescent, Kilmarnock.	Mr Jones expressed willingness to report the matter to the police.
Community Representative John McIvor requested that further consideration be given to traffic calming within Gatehead.	The Senior Engineer (Roads) undertook to arrange a further traffic survey in respect of this matter.
Named Substitute Maurice Ashbridge requested information on the criteria for traffic calming on Irvine Road, Kilmarnock.	The Senior Engineer (Roads) undertook to provide the information in question.
Community Representative John Donaldson expressed concern at confusion caused by the new traffic lights at Glencairn Square.	The Senior Engineer (Roads) and Councillor Walsh confirmed that the matter would be the subject of ongoing monitoring.
Community Representative John Donaldson expressed concern about a possible pedestrian safety issue arising from a gap in the railings adjacent to the traffic lights at High Glencairn Street.	The Senior Engineer (Roads) confirmed the view that steps would be taken to address this matter.
Named Substitute Ian McVey expressed concerns at possible road safety issues arising from the phasing of pedestrian crossing and traffic lights at West George Street and London Road at the Dick Institute respectively and about impaired visibility caused by the height of a hedge at Alloway Avenue, Kilmarnock.	The Senior Engineer (Roads) undertook to look into these matters.
