RECRUITMENT OF COMMUNITY REPRESENTATIVES 2002/2003

Report by the Depute Chief Executive/Director of Corporate Resources

1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

- 1.1 To advise of the position in respect of the appointment of Community Representatives of local organisations to serve on the Kilmarnock Central Local Committee for the period from 1 April 2002 to 31 March 2003.

2. BACKGROUND

- 2.1 The Kilmarnock Central Local Committee at its meeting on 22 January 2002 agreed to remit to the Depute Chief Executive/Director of Corporate Resources the initiation of the process for the submission of new nominations for Community Representatives and Named Substitutes by the relevant organisations, to serve during the period 1 April 2002 to 31 March 2003 and to make such arrangements as might be necessary to facilitate this process.
- 2.2 As Members are aware, the Local Committee agreed to retain the current Community Organisation Representation on the Local Committee, namely:-
- (a) Five members from the appropriate Community Councils;
 - (b) One member from the appropriate Elderly Forum Interest Groups;
 - (c) One member from the Disability Forums;
 - (d) One member from the Youth Forum (or equivalent);
 - (e) One member from churches in the area; and
 - (f) One member from the business community.
