MATTER RAISED	ACTION TAKEN
Community Representative John Tannock sought clarification on the current position in terms of responsibility for the cleaning of pigeon droppings under railway bridges.	The Director of Community Services explained that the implications in Scotland of a recent case in England were still awaited and also that he had written to the Scottish Executive to ask them to change the Animal Droppings Order to include pigeons.
Community Representative Linda Thomson reported on the misuse of disabled parking spaces within the grounds of Grange Academy.	The Head Teacher of Grange Academy agreed to look into this matter.
Named Substitute Maurice Ashbridge requested an update on the pilot scheme for the control of dog fouling within Gatehead.	The Director of Community Services agreed to submit a progress report in respect of this matter after the pilot scheme had been running a year.
Community Representative Robert Jones requested contact with the Dog Warden in connection with recent incidents in the grounds of Shortlees Primary School.	The Director of Community Services agreed to look into this matter.
Community Representative John McIvor expressed concern about issues of road safety in connection with the reduced number of barriers at the railway crossing in Gatehead, particularly in the light of an incident involving a visually impaired local resident.	The Senior Roads Engineer agreed to look into this matter.
