<p>Community Representative John Mclvor referred to, and expressed dissatisfaction with, a response received from the Department of Development Services in respect of public conveniences within the railway station which were only accessible by means of a key.</p>	<p>Individual Community Councils invited to write directly to Railtrack in respect of this matter.</p>	<p>To be advised by Community Council representatives.</p>
<p>Community Representative Maurice Ashbridge expressed concern that containers for recycling household waste (namely newspapers) at Western Road, Kilmarnock were not being emptied regularly enough to meet demand.</p>	<p>Memo to Director of Community Services.</p>	<p>Head of Protective Services wrote to Mr Ashbridge on 20 May 2002 to indicate that (i) whilst the main waste paper skip was full, there were other skips available for depositing newspapers; and (ii) the Council was reviewing its provision of waste paper banks with a view to improving the service in the near future.</p>
<p>Community Representative Esther Caldwell requested information on the Council Policy in respect of the future adoption by the Council of constructed by voluntary bodies such as Community Councils.</p>	<p>The Administration Manager advised that future maintenance issues would be assessed during consideration by the Council of any application for funding of playparks proposed by community groups. It was noted that external awarding bodies would also take this into account.</p>	<p>Matter dealt with.</p>
