Refer the matter to the Head of Corporate Development and Communications to respond direct.
<b>2</b>	Matt Donnelly - requested clarification of why the essential guide to shopping in Kilmarnock referred to businesses which had ceased trading.	Refer matter to Kilmarnock Town Centre Management Initiative for action and response direct.
<b>3</b>	Matt Donnelly - requested update on the re-siting of bus stop at Amlaird Road and Thorn Terrace.	Reported site visit arranged with Local Member. Head of Roads and Transportation to respond direct following site visit.  Local member confirmed position.
<b>4</b>	Matt Donnelly -requested clarification of ownership of wall adjacent to footpath at Campbellton Drive (adjacent to Dunoon Avenue).	Head of Roads and Transportation/Head of Legal and Administrative Services to respond direct.  Noted that the local member had also raised this matter.
<b>5</b>	Matt Donnelly - requested update on repairs to Longpark Community Centre.	Director of Homes and Technical Services to respond direct.  Noted that the local member had also raised this matter.

Service Manager (Older People) confirmed that a review of support to lunch clubs was being undertaken by the Council and that details of the review would be reported to the Social Work Committee in Spring 2001.
