1	Matt Donnelly - Re-siting of bus stop at Amlaird Road and Thorn Terrace - request for update.	Head of Roads and Transportation investigating road safety issues and will report back further.
2	Matt Donnelly - Provision of grass cutting at vacant Council homes.	Paul McVey advised that 2000/01 grass cutting at vacant Council housing was on an ad hoc basis and vacant house maintenance garden contract would be let for 2001/02.
3	Janet Smith - Requested removal of coping stone and bricks lying on footpath at Campbeltown Drive (adjacent to Dunoon Avenue).	Head of Roads and Transportation to investigate.  Noted that Councillor D Coffey had raised this matter separately with the Head of Roads and Transportation.
4	Maureen Brown - Requested that overhanging branches on South Dean Road be cut as they were causing problems for double decker buses.	Director of Community Services to investigate and take appropriate action.  Noted that Councillor John Weir had raised this matter separately with the Director of Community Services.
5	Maureen Brown - Requested details of how an Essential Guide to Kilmarnock was distributed and the costs associated.	Local Committee Administrative Officer to contact Kilmarnock Town Centre Initiative to request details and respond accordingly.
6	Matt Donnelly - Requested details on progress regarding the street naming of a development at Kennedy Drive, New Farm Loch.	Local Committee Administrative Officer to confirm progress of street naming at "Dean View" with the Director of Homes and Technical Services.
7	Longpark Community Centre - Progress of repairs.	Director of Homes and Technical Services to advise Councillor D Coffey of progress of repair works.
