1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

- 1.1** To advise of the resignation of the Community Representative and Substitute Representative for the Disabled and to advise of progress to fill the vacancies.

2. BACKGROUND

- 2.1** The resignation of Mary Cameron, Community Representative for the Disabled and Jim Cameron, Substitute Community Representative was intimated in a letter dated 18 May 2000 to the Secretary of the Kilmarnock Forum on Disability.
- 2.2** During the summer recess, contact was made with the Secretary of the Federation of Community Groups for Kilmarnock North and the Secretary of the Kilmarnock Forum on Disability to establish if there were any nominations for the vacancies.
- 2.3** It was established that Dorothy McGowan had expressed an interest in being nominated as a Community Representative for the Disabled. Currently, there is a vacancy for the Substitute Community Representative for the Disabled.

3. PRESENT POSITION

- 3.1** The Kilmarnock Forum on Disability has nominated Dorothy McGowan and it is understood that the nominee has already met with the Federation of Community Groups of Kilmarnock North.

5. RECOMMENDATIONS

- 5.1** It is recommended that the Local Committee:-
- (i) agree the appointment of the Community Representative for the Disabled; and
