In addition, the problem regarding the side-lines at the roundabout at this location would also be reviewed.</p>   |
| Anne McRoberts | <p><b><u>Request for a Road Safety Sign</u></b></p> <p>An enquiry was made requesting that consideration be given to the erection of a road safety sign saying "slow - children" in the Kilmarnock South area when entering Caprington Avenue, Loreny Drive and Blacksyke Avenue from the Ayr Road approach.</p> | <p>Memo to be issued to the Roads Division.</p>   |
| Anne McRoberts | <p><b><u>Trees at Caprington Avenue</u></b></p> <p>Reference was made to an issue which had been raised at the Forum meeting on 24 October 2000 regarding the need for the trees at Caprington Avenue to be lopped.</p>  | <p>It was reported, prior to the Local Committee in 31 January 2001 verbal confirmation had been given by the Director of Community Services that this work had been carried out.</p> <p>Councillor Knapp stated that he would be pursuing the matter with the Director of Community Services and would request a site meeting with himself, Councillor Darnbrough, the Director of Community Services with Anne McRoberts in attendance.</p> |

| Arthur Brown          | <p><b><u>Reinstatement of Pavement at Tinto Avenue</u></b></p> <p>It was reported that following a repair to a burst pipe in December at Tinto Avenue the pavement had not been fully reinstated and that at some sections there was a significant drop from the pavement onto the road. As a consequence, Mr Brown advised that buses were having difficulty in negotiating the corner which was part of their route.</p> | Memo to be issued to the Director of Development Services.  |
| Peggy Shaw            | <p><b><u>Shortlees Community House</u></b></p> <p>An update report was requested on the future use of the Shortlees Community House.</p>   | It was agreed that an update be provided for the next meeting of the Committee by the Area Housing Manager.   |
| Councillor Darnbrough | <p><b><u>Abandoned Vehicles</u></b></p> <p>Concern was expressed regarding an abandoned vehicle which had not been removed from Shortlees Crescent for 8 weeks.</p>  | The Police Liaison Officer reported that he was aware of this matter and advised that owing to a breakdown in the procedure for dealing with such incidences the vehicle had not been removed, but that the matter would be resolved in due course. |
