Anne McRoberts	<p><u>Street Lighting at Blacksyke Avenue</u></p> <p>Concern was expressed that street lighting at Blacksyke Avenue appeared to be permanently switched on.</p>	<p>The representative of the Department of Community Services noted this matter and undertook to address it.</p>
Anne McRoberts	<p><u>Public Conveniences within the Burns Shopping Mall</u></p> <p>Concern was expressed at the anticipated closure on Sundays of the public conveniences located within the Burns Shopping Mall. A related query was also made regarding the future availability of public conveniences within the refurbished bus station.</p>	<p>Councillor Knapp advised that no decision on revised opening times for public conveniences within the Burns Mall had been made and confirmed that the Local Committee would be advised of the outcome of a future report to the Community Services Committee.</p>
Anne McRoberts	<p><u>Licensing of Tattoo Parlours</u></p> <p>An enquiry was made as to the requirement for tattoo parlours to be licensed.</p>	<p>It was confirmed that a licensing system did apply to tattoo parlours and that the premises could be checked for compliance at any time, both in terms of licensing and environmental health.</p> <p>Superintendent Alistair McKie noted the Community Representative's concern in respect of a particular establishment and undertook to investigate the matter in consultation with the Department of Community Services.</p>
