1 Purpose of the group

CROSSHOUSE COMMUNITY COUNCIL

The group also aims to provide activities, which will occupy children and young people out of school hours.

2 Purpose of the grant

The grant will be used as a contribution towards the total cost of a FUN DAY, which will take place in Crosshouse on Saturday 23rd August 2003. The event will start with a fancy dress parade through the streets of the village and culminate in a variety of activities at Lindsay Park.

The grant will be used to fund the following items: inflatable football (£30), bouncy castle (£300), marquees (£500), band (£100), disco (£100), fairground attractions (£100), clown (£100), face painting (£20), ball pool (£25), hire of generators (£135), pole joust (£100)
