RECRUITMENT OF COMMUNITY REPRESENTATIVES - PROGRESS REPORT

Report by Depute Chief Executive/Director of Corporate Resources

1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

- 1.1** The purpose of the report is to advise the Local Committee of the progress to date in respect of the recruitment of Community Representatives and Named Substitutes from local organisations to serve on the Kilmarnock South Local Committee for the period 1 April 2003 to 31 March 2004.

2. BACKGROUND

- 2.1** The Kilmarnock South Local Committee, at their meeting held on 26 March 2003, agreed:-
- (i) to approve the nominations received to date for Community Representatives and Named Substitutes made by the local community organisations detailed in Appendix I of this report;
 - (ii) to note the position with regard to the efforts being made to recruit a Young Persons' representative for the Local Committee.
 - (iii) that it be remitted to the Depute Chief Executive/Director of Corporate Resources to make such arrangements as might be necessary to facilitate the submission of outstanding nominations for Community Representatives and Named Substitutes for the Kilmarnock South Local Committee.

3. PROGRESS TO DATE

- 3.1** Atrium Homes is liaising with the Chair of the recently constituted Community Resident Association within the Kilmarnock South area and it is anticipated that nominations will be forwarded in due course.
- 3.2** No nominations in respect of the Pre-5 sector have been received and the Director of Educational and Social Services has advised that, following consultation with Pre-5 organisations in the Kilmarnock South area, there are no individuals involved in this Sector who are willing to undertake this role.
- 3.3** Should any nominations be submitted over the current year for those organisational sectors for which vacancies remain then these will be submitted for approval to the next appropriate meeting of the Local Committee.

4. POLICY/FINANCIAL/LEGAL IMPLICATIONS - Nil

5. RECOMMENDATIONS

5.1 It is recommended:-

- (i) that the Local Committee note the progress to date in the recruitment process to fill the remaining vacancies for Community Representatives and Named Substitutes; and
- (ii) that the Local Committee receive a further report should any nominations be submitted over the current year for those organisational sectors for which vacancies remain.
